

Membership Renewal procedures are changing!!!

NHCRA is making a change in the membership term. Beginning January 1, 2012, our membership year will coincide with the calendar year.

What does this change mean for you? It means you will pay your dues once at the beginning of the calendar year, and not have to think about it again! We will ask all members to pay those dues by January 15 of each calendar year. If you have had trouble remembering your personal NHCRA renewal date on the present revolving system, this will make your life easier!

This change will make managing membership and membership dues easier for both the organization and members.

Here's how the transition will work:

If you have not yet paid dues in 2011, we encourage you to do so before June 1, 2011, the date of the Annual Meeting. You must be a paid member to vote at the annual meeting.

All annual dues paid between now and the end of 2011 will cover membership through December 31, 2012. That means if you pay your dues before the Annual meeting, you get 18 months of membership for the price of 12 months!

NOTE: Beginning January 2013, we will ask that dues be paid by January 15. All renewals will be for the calendar year of 2013. Late payments will be accepted but not prorated.

Change requires some flexibility. This change is no different. NHCRA board members will be available to assist with any questions or problems along the way. We will do our best to make things as seamless as possible. We ask for your patience.
